



UBC Cultural Cities Commission

Activity Report October 2013 – September 2015

The 4th Annual Forum of the European Union Strategy for the Baltic Sea Region (EUSBSR) will 11th-12th November 2013 in Vilnius, Lithuania. The Board took part in the Annual Forum and had a board meeting.

During the spring 2014 the commission worked with co-operation other cultural organization round the Baltic Sea. Board members took part in Culturability BSR – seminars in Rendsburg and in Riga. Culturability BSR aims to bring knowledge on culture as a driver for sustainable development – and through showcasing and demonstration encourage multiplication of good/best/next practices for culture and sustainability in the Baltic Sea Region and from that develop a number of high quality high impact projects in the field.

Commission Board meeting was held in Rendesburg during Culturability BSR – seminar.

The Chairperson Lone Leth Larsen resigned in May and vice chairperson Jaana Simula continued as a chairperson.

The Commission arranged Midnordic Culture Days 2014 in cooperation with the provinces of Satakunta and Ostrobothnia. The seminar was held in cities Pori and Rauma during 25th -26th September). Seminar is aimed for cultural field experts, researches, cultural organizations, students and others interested in cultural issues. The seminar had 64 participants from 5 countries: Finland, Ireland, Lithuania, Norway and Sweden. The topic of the seminar was World Heritage and issues of cultural, natural, industrial and intangible heritage. The seminar consisted of lectures, workshops, excursions and cultural program.

The board took part in the EUSBSR PA Culture meeting in Tallin on the 13-14th November and had board meeting.

Vice chairperson took part in following seminars as a panelist: 5th EUSBSR meeting in Turku 3-4th June 2014, 15-17th October BSSSC meeting in Jurmala, 13-14th November 2014 EUSBSR PA Culture “Learning from the past – Looking into the Future” in Tallin, 1-2th December, Round Table “Baltic Sea Regional Identity: Is it only a CBSS long term priority?” in Stockholm and also took part in Cool North - Cultural Diplomacy in Nordic Countries 8-9th October in Copenhagen.

2015

Year 2015 started with the work of the new UBC. The new culture commission – now UBC Cultural Cities Commission presented the Vision and Action Plan made in Tallin in November 2014 at the UBC 72nd General Meeting in Kemi 26th of February, Finland

Gdańsk, The Cultural Gathering was arranged by the Ministry of Culture and National Heritage of Poland and the main event was the conference "Culture as a driving force for social and economic development of the region". The chairperson also took part in the 6th EUSBSR PA Culture Steering Group Meeting.

During 4-8th of November the Cesis Culture Department (Latvia) made a professional visit to Pori, Finland in September as a part of Nordic-Baltic Mobility program.
