The revised version of the **Action Plan** was approved by the EUSBSR National Coordinators' Group in their meeting in June 2020.

- Horizontal Actions Capacity, Climate and Neighbors will be mainstreamed in all Policy Areas (14);
- Interim period until January 2022 when the Baltic Sea Strategy Point is up;
